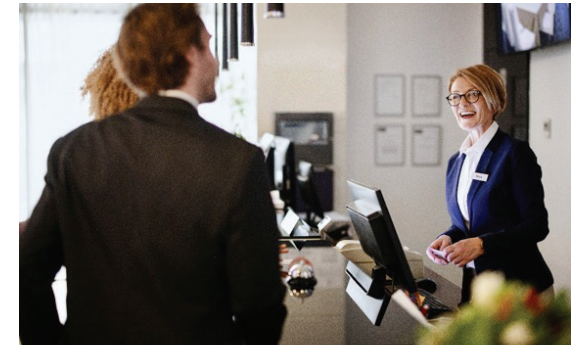
### Food Service Equipment
