CELEBRATE DRINKING WATER WEEK

Drinking Water Week is being celebrated nationally May 7-13. It's a terrific time to highlight the great benefits of BWL water.

The BWL water supply is plentiful, coming from 124 wells throughout the Lansing area, pumping 100 percent of the water from approximately 400 feet underground from the Saginaw Aquifer.

There are over 800 miles of water main that are continually worked on to make infrastructure updates and ensure quality water is supplied to you. The BWL takes many steps to confirm the water is there when you need it, including working to replace several miles

of water mains every year. Additionally, every year hydrants and valves are inspected to guarantee they operate properly to deliver water to you for drinking, laundry, washing

or fighting fires. In addition to upgrades and inspections, the BWL was the second utility in the country to remove lead service lines.

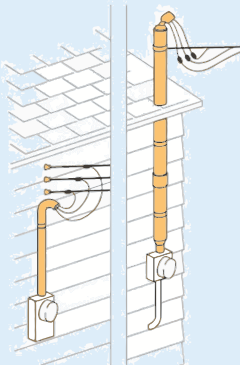

BWL's Mast Repair Program

Summer in Michigan is synonymous with two things: road construction and severe weather. When storms move in, they often bring with them powerful winds that can cause damage to a service mast.

If your mast is damaged, you are responsible for the repairs to the equipment shaded in orange below. It is critical repairs be made to the mast before the BWL is able to restore power to any home or business. Customers may use any of the BWL approved electrical contractors to have repairs made and payments financed interest free for 12 months. You can also choose to pay off your statement early without penalty.
